1) The replacement electric motor for the cargo bike came in at £1555. Jane made immediate payment for this from her own funds and indicated that she wished to bear some of the cost. Committee have now however decided that all of the cost should be reimbursed. An initial payment of £1037 was made in September and the balance in November when further funds became available.									
2) The recently-opened Grant Account currently has a balance of £3111 - £3960 initial deposit less payments for Riverside and Woodpecker youth club events and a Pepys Park Dr. Bike. It is understood by the terms of the grant that these monies are restricted to activities in the Deptford area only.
