We are in quite good financial shape as can be seen from the attached Ongoing Budget.

Despite the losses of income from the cancelled Ride London event and a hoped-for payment for assisting with the Dunwich Dynamo donation income has been considerable.

Outgoings have been less than normal due to some reduction in activities and events as a result of coronavirus restrictions.

It is estimated that we'll have close on £1,500 at the close of the financial year next March.

We were selected for a full audit this year by the London Cycling Campaign and passed this successfully.
